The **Newberry Ballet Guild** was established by Kendyl Griffith and Peggy Wilson as a non-profit organization intended to promote the art of dance in Newberry County. Since its inception in 1977, the Newberry Ballet Guild has presented numerous classical ballets, as well as original ballets and modern dances for local and non-local patrons.

Our dancers have performed with an internationally touring Russian ballet company, and have participated in master classes led by world-renowned dance troupes. Many of its members have also attended the prestigious SC Governor's School for the Arts in Greenville and have pursued dance at the college level or beyond.



Our Pre-Apprentice program offers pre-ballet students an opportunity to advance their ballet training and provide them with experience performing on-stage. Unlike our regular membership, Pre-Apprentices are not required to pay membership fees or obtain sponsorships.

Our season runs from September to May, with our major production taking place in January. Rehearsals are held on Saturdays from 9:00am to 2:00pm. Typically, younger students are not scheduled to rehearse for the entire day. Our Pre-Apprentices are allowed to participate with limited commitment, meaning they would not rehearse as often until production time draws near.

Pre-Apprentice Program Policies

Age Requirements

Your dancer must be 6 years old by June 15th.

Absentee Policy

Rehearsals: Students are allowed two (2) excused absences, which must be submitted in advance to the artistic directors.

Classes: Students are required to make up their missed classes after three (3) absences.

Rehearsal Policy

All members are required to attend rehearsals when called upon. A dancer's membership may be revoked if they have excessive absences, whether excused or unexcused.

Class Policy

All dancers are required to take at least two ballet classes per week. Dancers are also required to take classes during our summer session, which lasts about six weeks.
